





Latvia template settings with ICAD

1. Extract zip file “localization of Carlson Survey”
2. Open extracted file “localization of Carlson Survey”
3. Double click and install the folder “topo_palette_14012020” – Note: this will be extracted to a default folder C:\topo palette

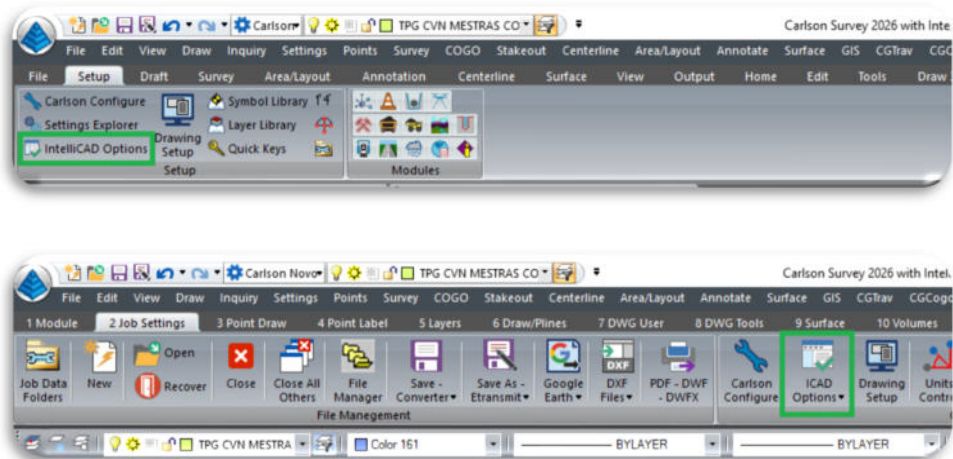

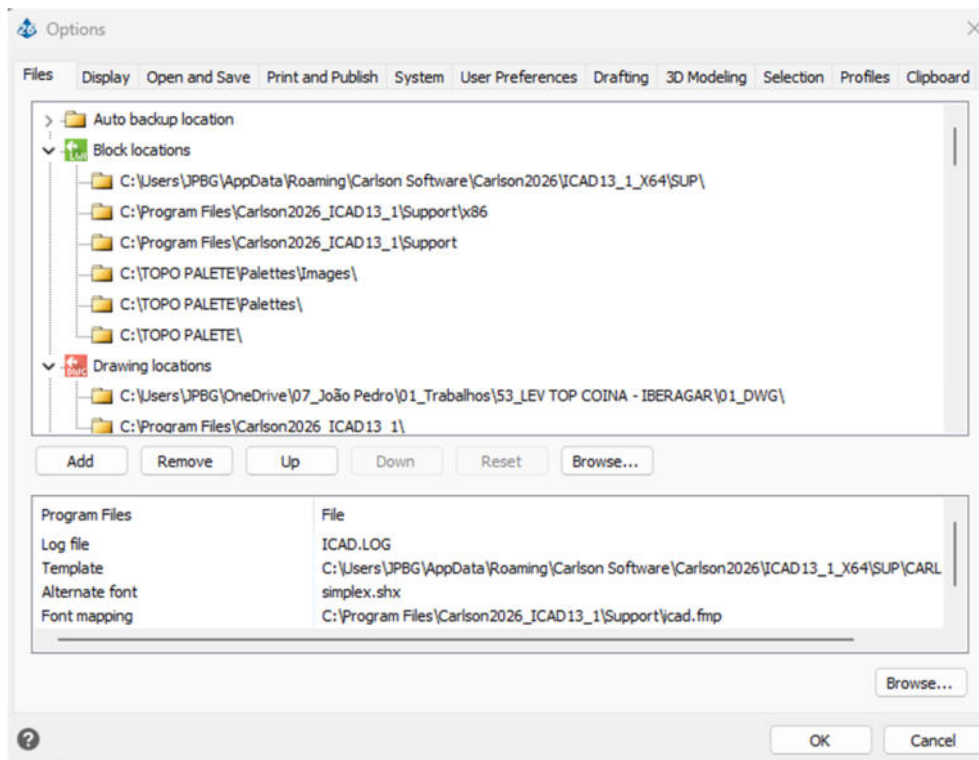


5. open Carlson Civil suite and type “_options” in the command line or go to Icon ICAD options.



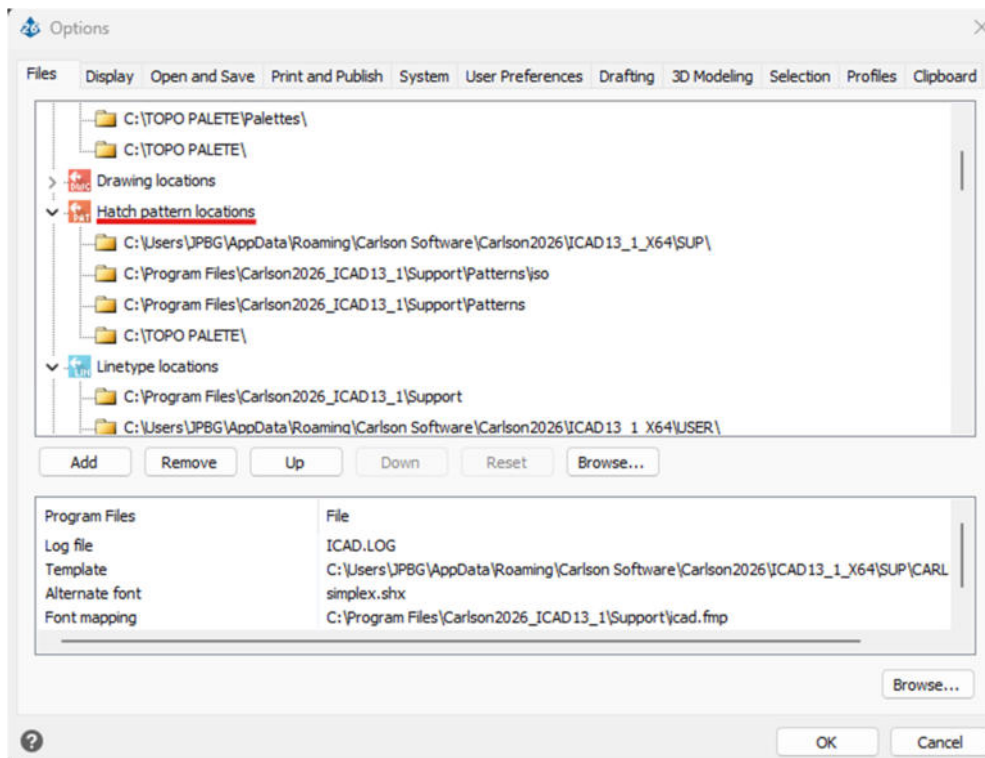
6. Select tab “files” and follow the next steps defined on the following pictures:

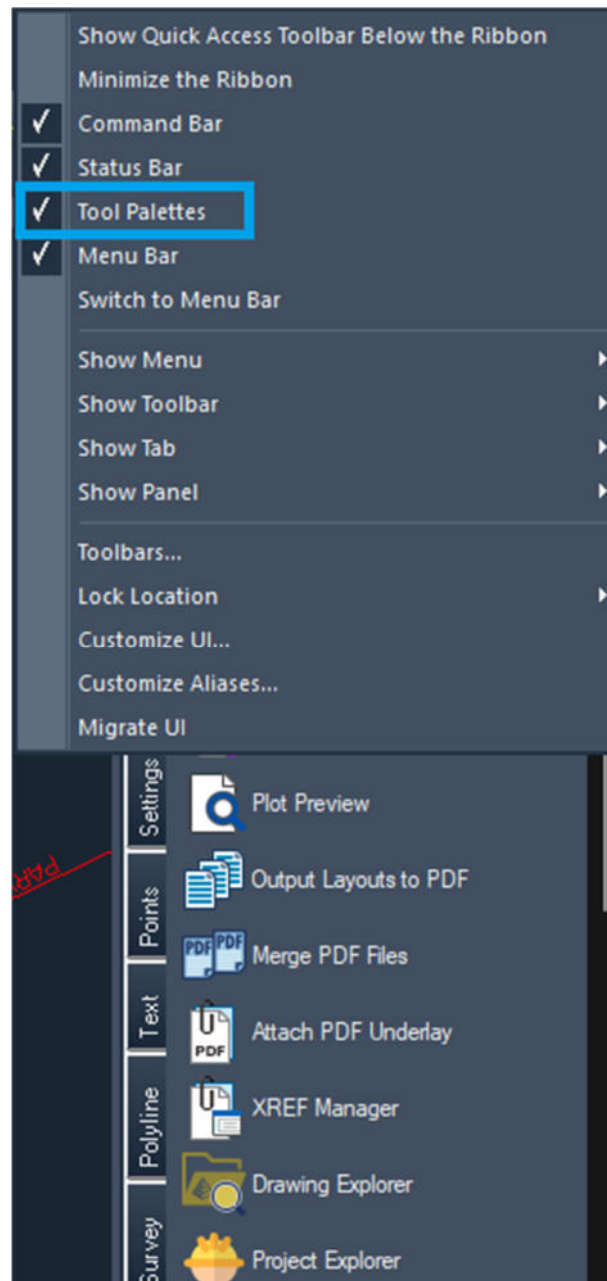


7. With the right location of the pallet folders, just click ok and it will be saved.
8. It will have a merged pallet, Both Carlson and Latvia in one, or others if you already created more than this one.



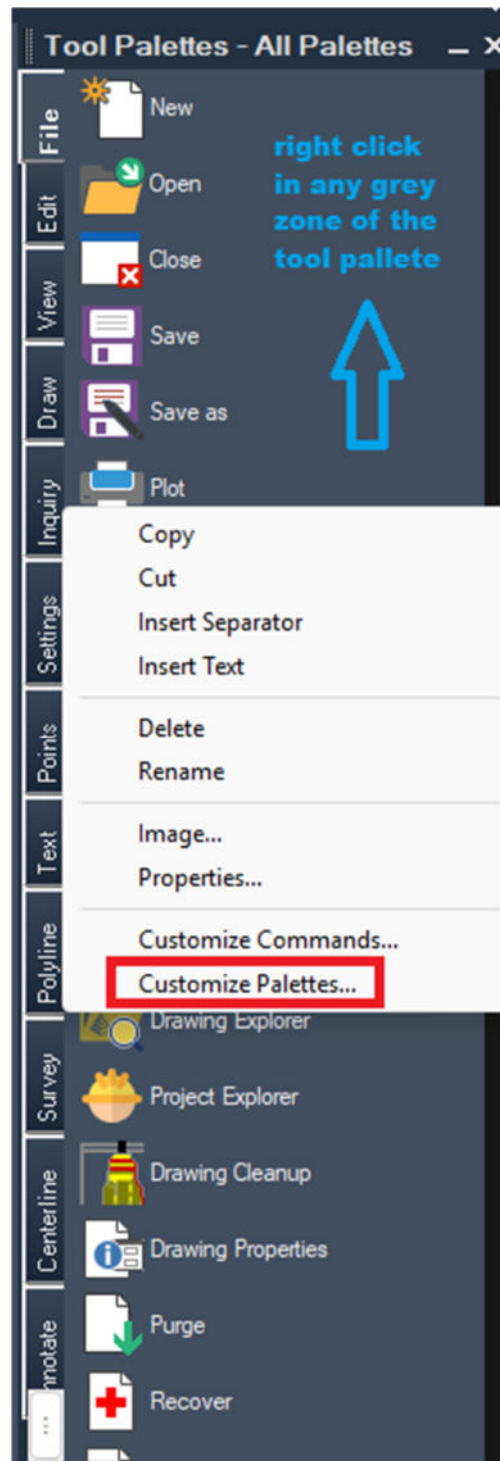


9. Setting the tool palettes – Open tool palettes using right click on the workspace top, should have that look:





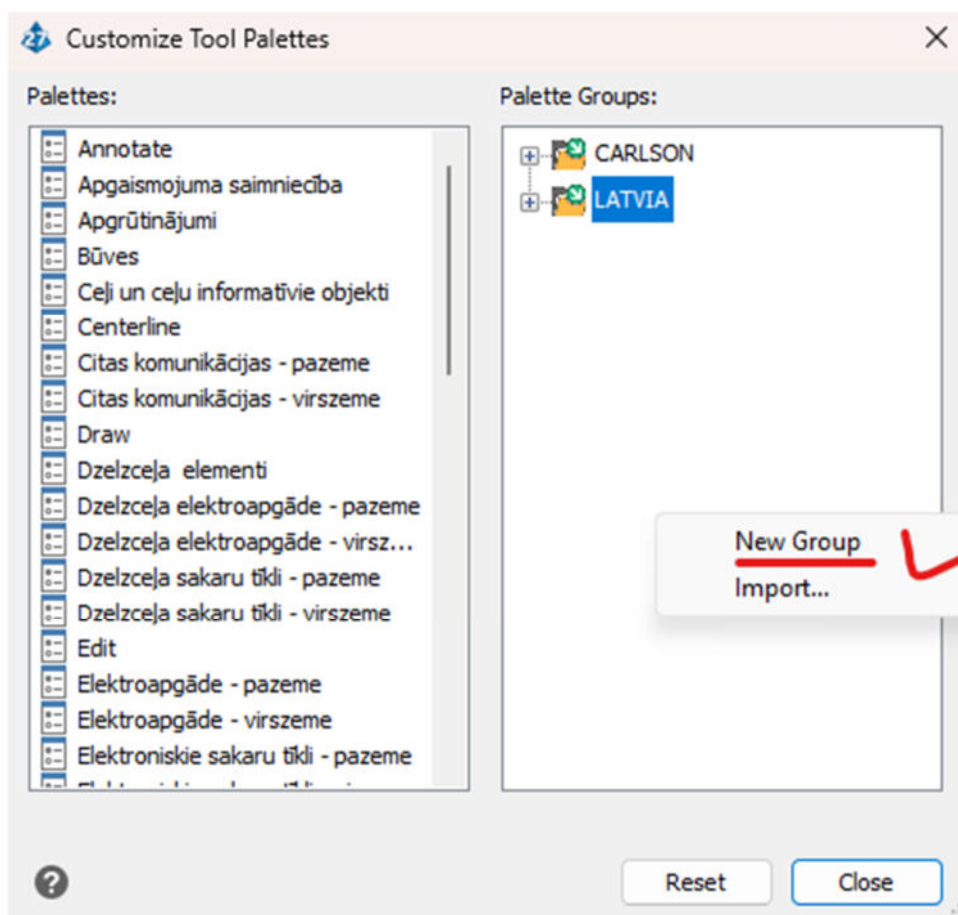
10. After opening the tool palettes, go to any grey zone on the tool palettes and right click picking the option “Customize palettes”:





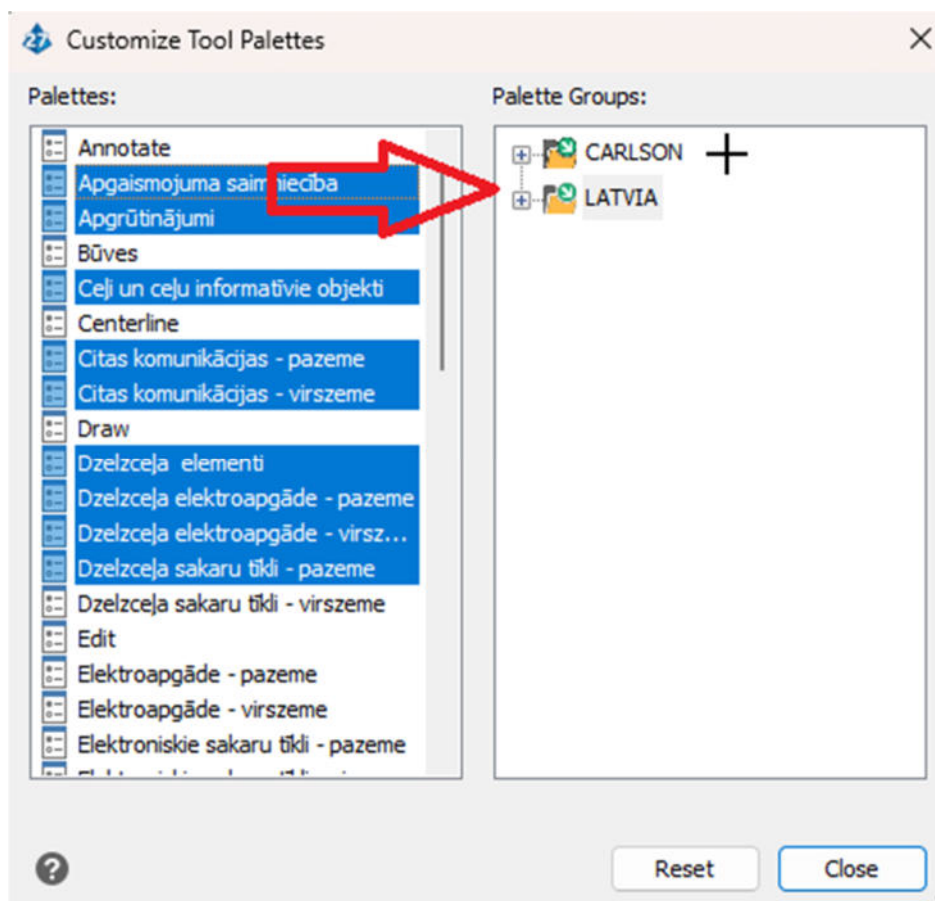
11. Creating palette groups, right click on the right side, normally it's blank if you didn't create previously pallets groups.

In this example, we created Latvia and Carlson groups to be used independently, but you can keep it using one palette only, if not, proceed with next step:





12. Adding palettes to groups – Select any palettes from the left that you want to add to any group, left click mouse (keep pressed - long press) and release it to the correspondent group.





13. Changing between palette groups – right click on the top of the palettes dialogue and you'll have available all groups created as well as all palettes option which includes all palettes.
